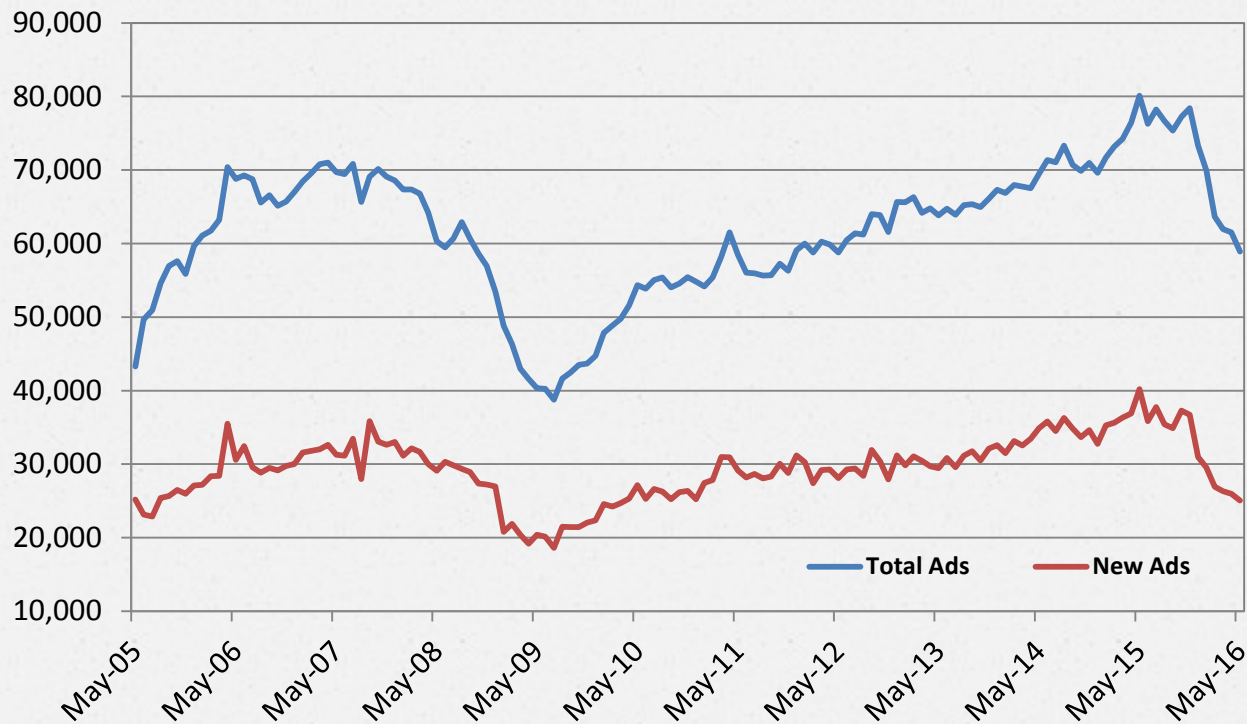


# What is HWOL?

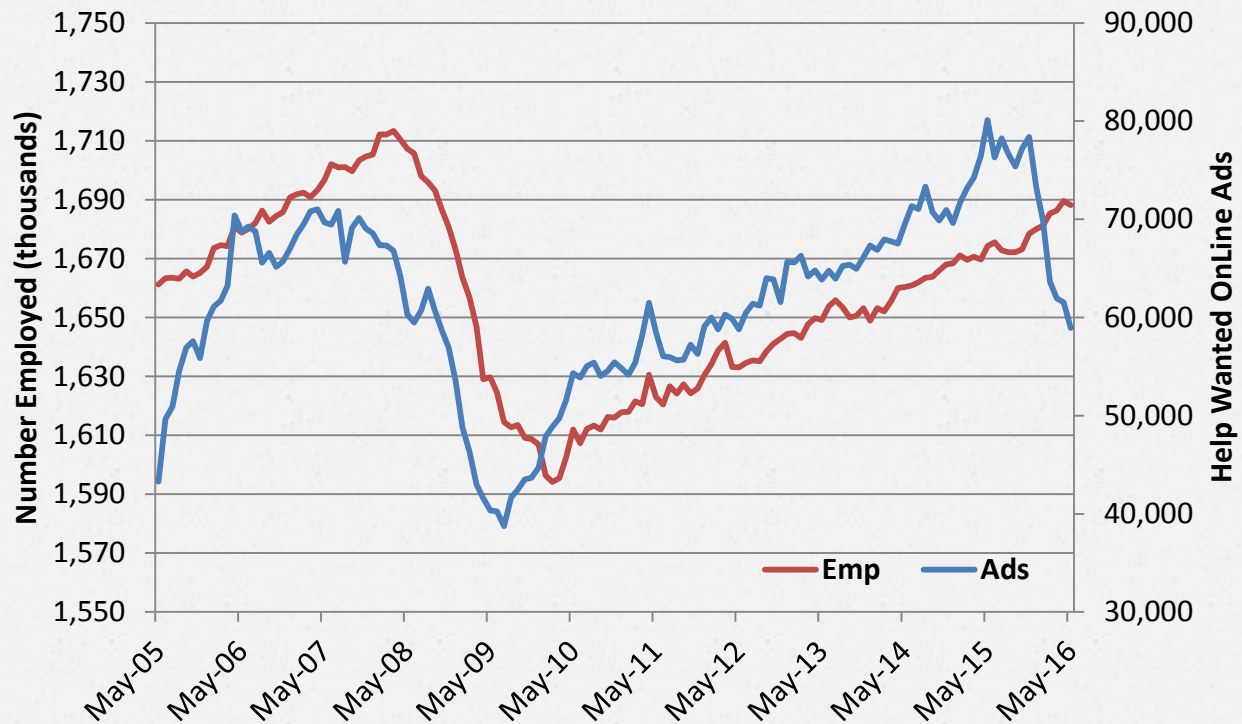

Seasonally Adjusted, through May 2016



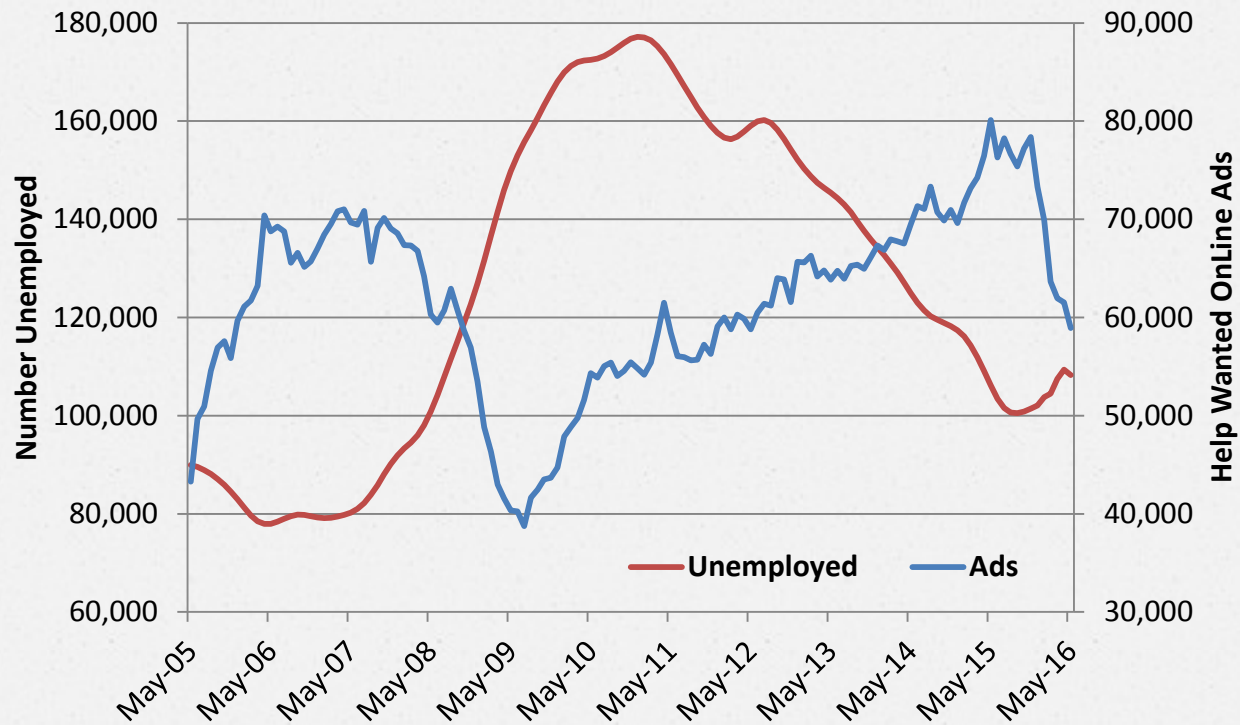
# Employment vs. Labor Demand

CT Seasonally Adjusted Data, through May 2016



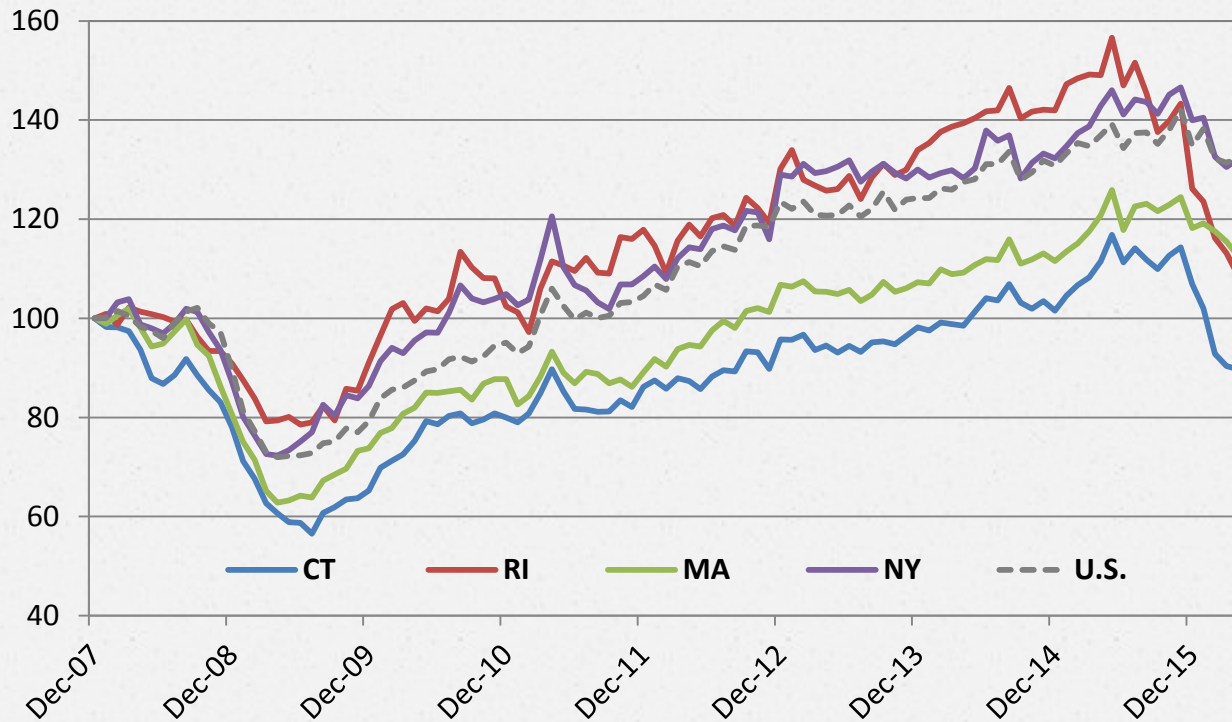
# Labor Supply vs. Labor Demand

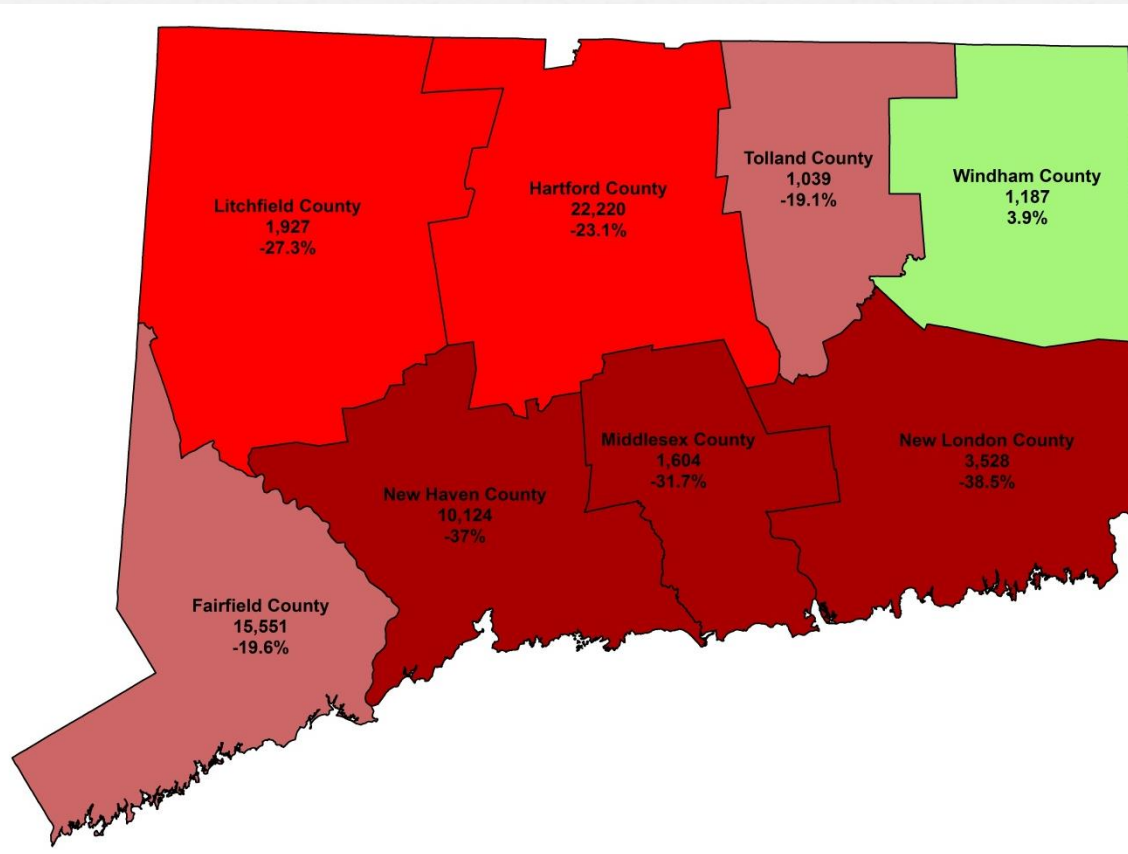

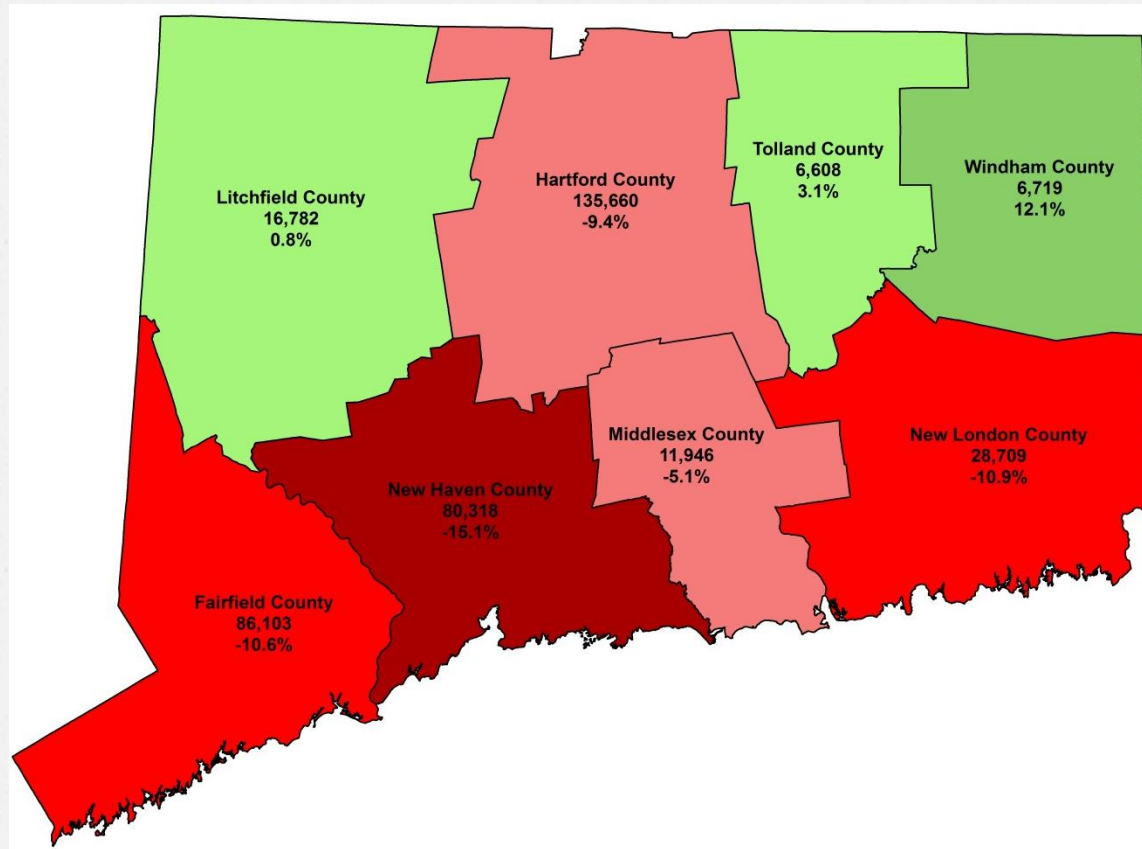
# Available Job Ads, by County

(Total of past year and % change from previous year)

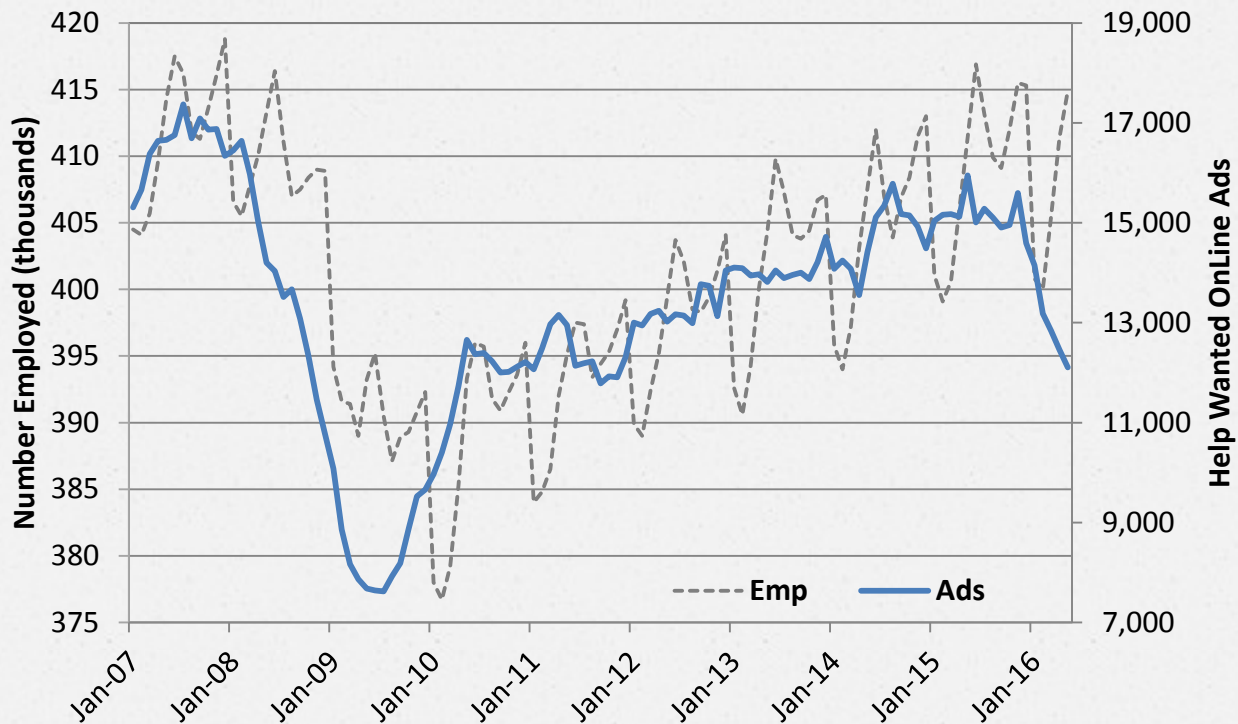

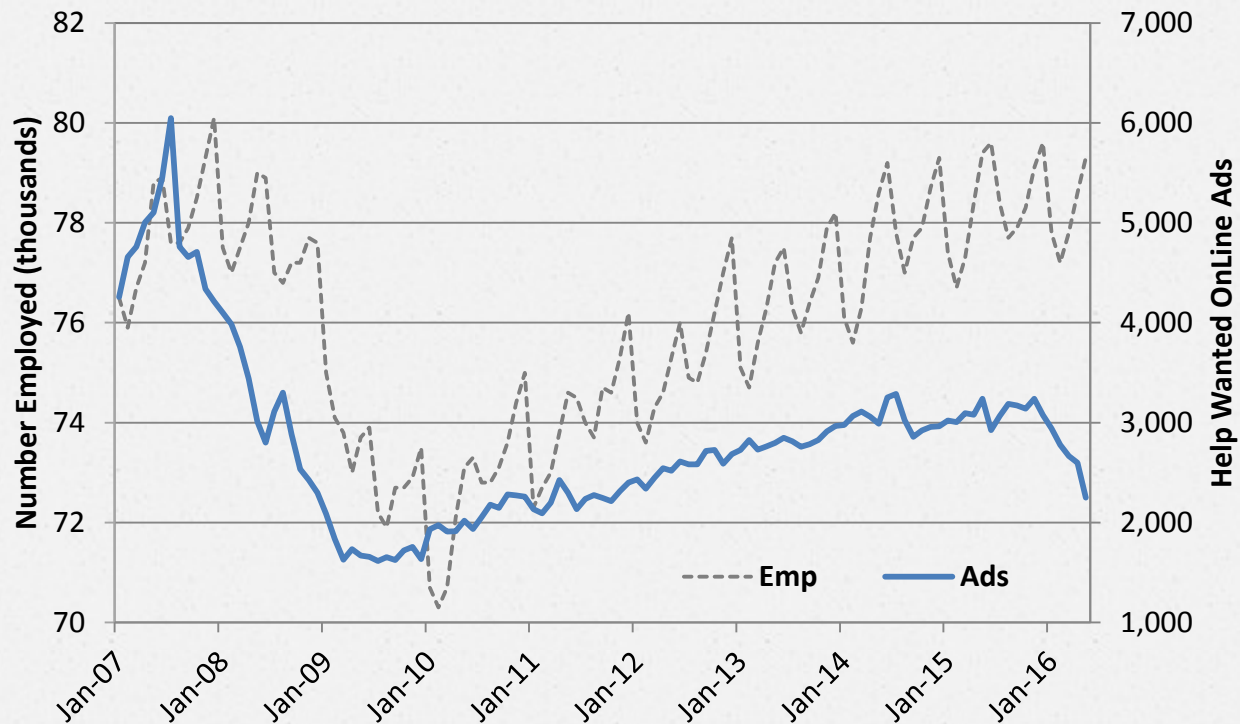

Employment vs. Labor Demand (Not Seasonally Adjusted), through May 2016



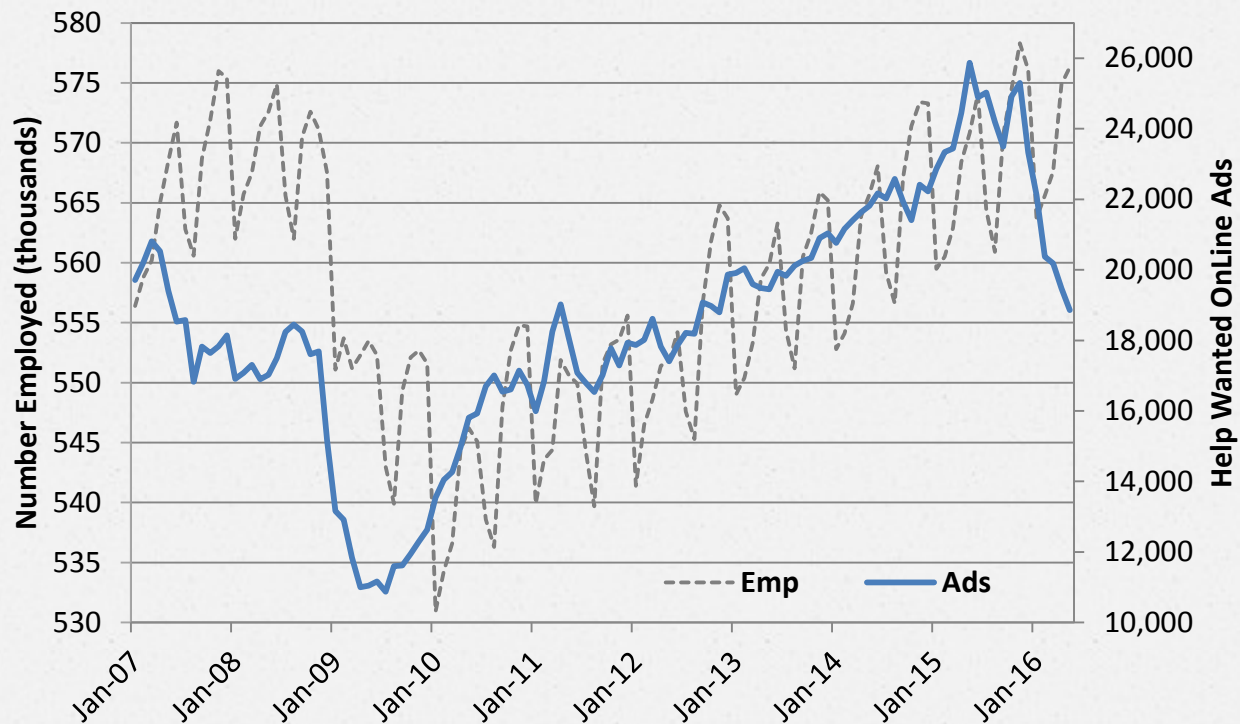
# Danbury LMA

Employment vs. Labor Demand (Not Seasonally Adjusted), through May 2016



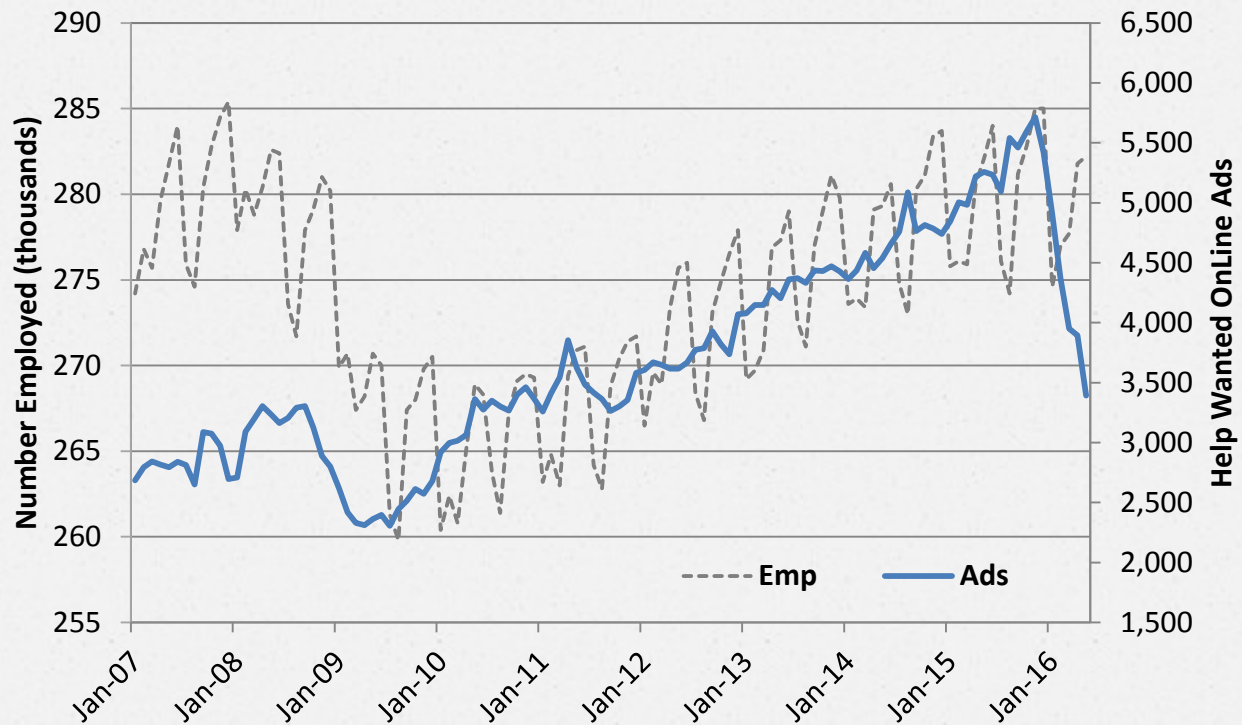
# Hartford LMA

Employment vs. Labor Demand (Not Seasonally Adjusted) , through May 2016



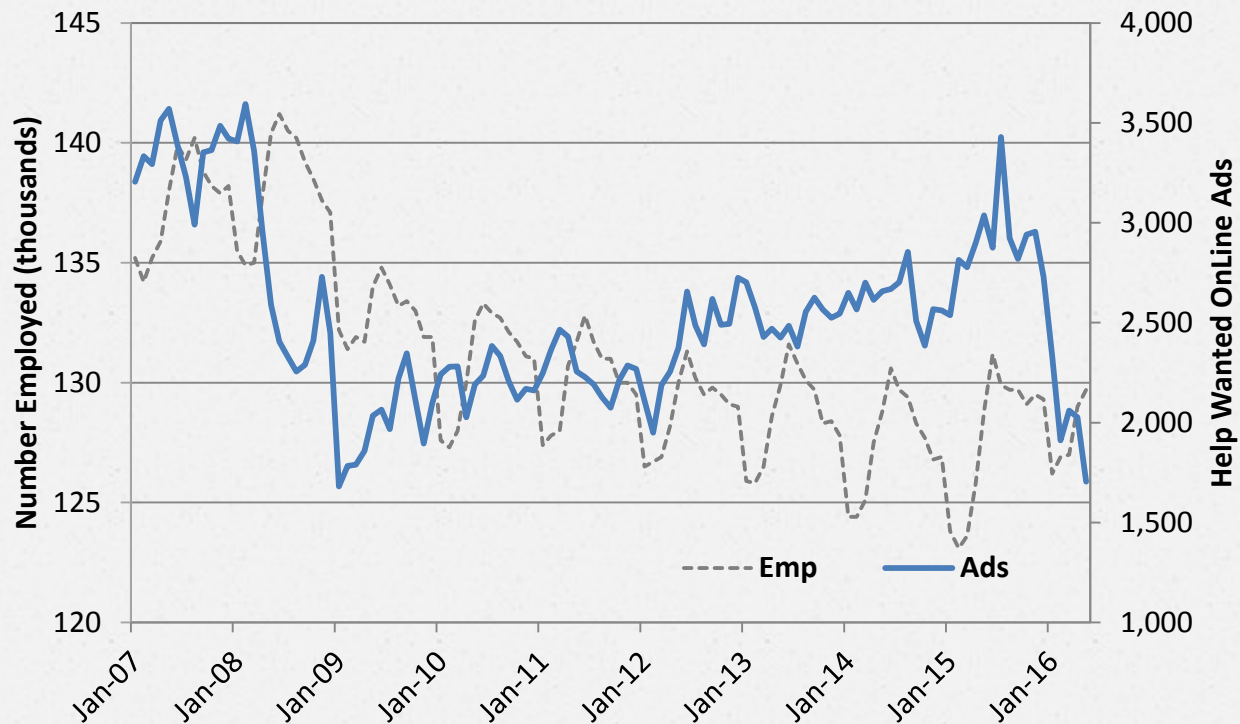
# New Haven LMA

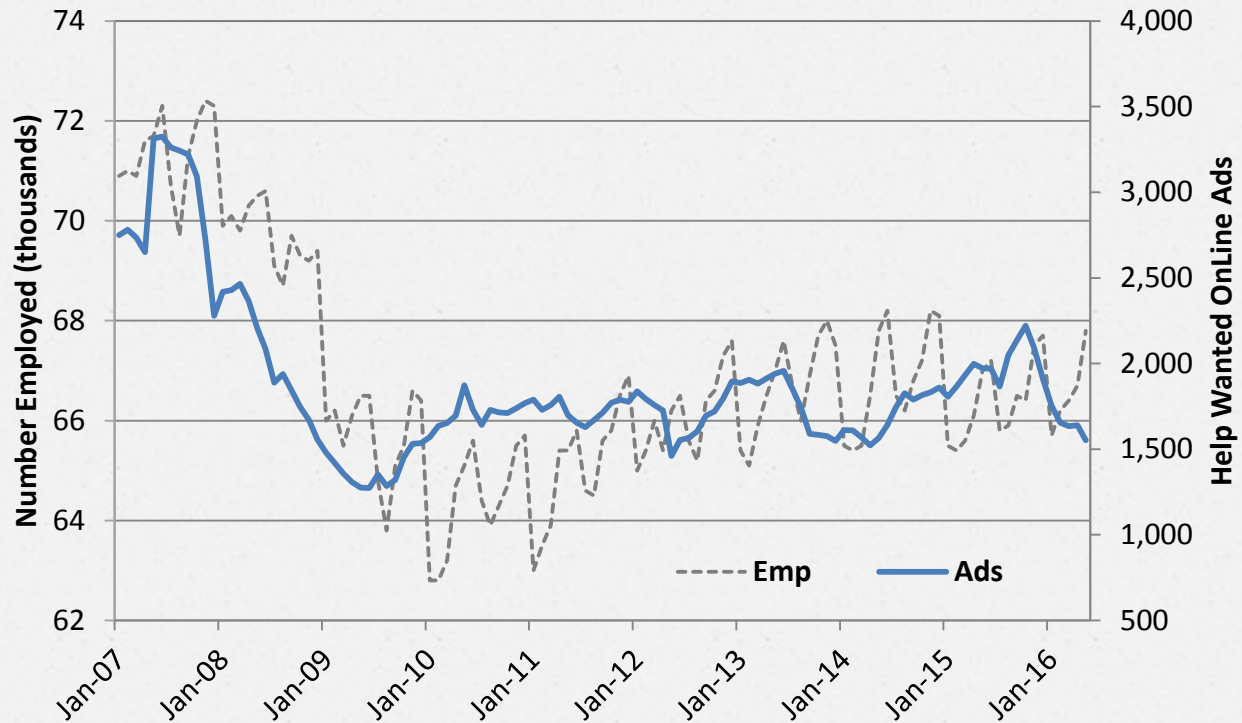
Employment vs. Labor Demand (Not Seasonally Adjusted) , through May 2016
